Prescribed Fire Burn Window: October 15 – December 29, 2017

You may see smoke at times during the dates above because The Nature Conservancy will be conducting Prescribed Burns on our Lower Chrome Preserve in Elk Township, north of the intersection of Barren Road, Chrome Road and State Road. These burns are carefully planned and implemented, and are a necessary vegetation management tool to maintain the unusual native vegetation and wildlife at this site.

The Prescribed burns are conducted under precise, closely monitored weather conditions and by a specially trained crew that is nationally qualified in prescribed fire. Every precaution is taken to ensure the safety of the public and the burn crew, and the prescribed burns will not take place if the proper weather and fuel conditions are not met.
